Ivy Leaves

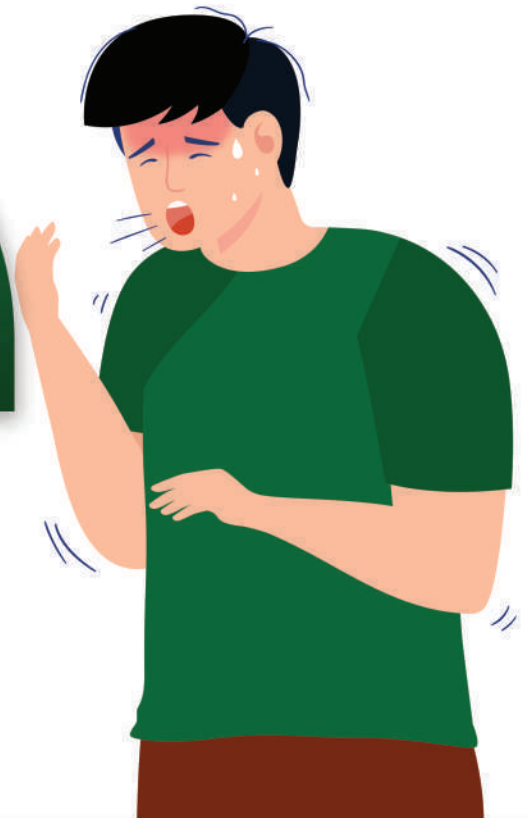
Used as an expectorant that allows the mucus to be coughed up in the productive cough, It liquefies the sticky mucus trapped in the lungs airways resulting in relaxing and widening the air passages so patient can breathe better.

Thyme Leaves

It contains compounds called flavonoids that relax the throat muscles involved in coughing and lessen inflammation, It has mucolytic effect

Licorice root extract

Used as a potent expectorant, loosening, and expelling mucus. It has demulcent and anti-inflammatory properties.

- ❖ Most probably cough will persist for 1-2 weeks

- ❖ Complications for cough are exacerbation of asthma, pain , rupture of nasal and subconjunctival veins , cough induced vomiting.
- ❖ Cough is a reason for patient inconvenience as it causes sleep disruption , headache and dizziness
